So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God. GALATIANS 4:7

(Read also GALATIANS 4:1-6.)

The apostle Paul made clear in this verse who we are in Christ. Jesus came to free us from being slaves and made us sons and heirs. Our identity in God is not something we have to work hard for; it is a free gift. Today, we will see how Christ redeems us from slavery into being God's children and heirs.

2 Son

⁴But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, ⁵to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.

GALATIANS 4:4,5

Jesus was sent to the earth, born as a human like us, under the law, to redeem us from slavery. To redeem means to be bought at a price—Jesus bought us back from slavery with His blood, paying for us with His life. Because of this sacrifice, we can receive adoption as sons. How are slaves different from sons? What does 2 Corinthians 6:18 say about our relationship with God?
